## **GUHSD Reappoints Six Members to Second, Consecutive Term on Citizens Bond Oversight Committee**

*Six Members of East County Prop. H Group to Continue Service through June 30, 2008*

(EL CAJON, CA) \_ At a Special Board Meeting on Thursday, June 29, 2006, the Governing Board of the Grossmont Union High School District (GUHSD) approved the reappointment of six current members of its Citizens Bond Oversight Committee.

The six original members were reappointed as follows:

Ron Pennock - Representing the business community located within GUHSD  
Charles Muse - Representing senior citizens  
William Wells - Representing parent/guardian of a child enrolled in GUHSD  
Harold Hilliker - Representing members of a parent teacher organization  
James R. Davis - Representing the GUHSD community-at-large  
C. Phillip Jankola - Representing the GUHSD community-at-large

The seventh member, Walter Heiser, fills the taxpayers' association designation and is an active member of the San Diego County Taxpayers' Association. Heiser was appointed to fill that opening on September 2, 2005, and his initial two-year term will expire on September 2, 2007.

"It's my pleasure to renew the appointments of these hardworking and truly committed individuals," said School Board President Jim Kelly. "We've appreciated their service and the very important oversight role they perform on behalf of our students and the entire taxpayer community."

The purpose of the independent Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee is to receive and review copies of annual, public performance and financial audits; and to review and report on the proper expenditure of taxpayers' money for school construction. The Committee shall advise the public as to whether the District is in compliance with the requirements of Section 1 of Article XIII A of the California Constitution.
