Allows for 11-day Winter Break and 5-day Spring Break. Last day of regular school will be Wednesday, June 20, 2012.

NOTE: First semester has 18 weeks and second semester has 20 weeks. Reporting periods are every six (6) weeks for first semester; for second semester the first reporting period is 6 weeks; the second and last reporting periods are seven (7) weeks.
