School Bus Safety Rules

The following rules and regulations have been established by State law and the Board of Trustees. The Board has elected to provide limited transportation although home-to-school transportation for General Education students is not required by the State.

A Bus Pass or Ride Ticket is required at all times to ride the School Bus.

1. Bus Passes and Ride Tickets must be presented to the driver immediately upon entering the bus.
2. Students failing to present a bus pass or ride ticket 3 times may be denied transportation.
3. The bus driver is in charge at all times. Follow the driver's instructions.
4. Students must conduct themselves at all times in a manner which shows respect for property and consideration for others. Actions such as littering, spitting, throwing of objects at, within, or out of the bus, vandalism or harassment of others will not be tolerated.
5. Students need to arrive at their bus stop a minimum of 10 minutes prior to the designated pickup time.
6. When you see the bus coming, move back ten (10) feet from the stop and line up for loading. Enter and leave the bus in an orderly manner.
7. Animals, birds, reptiles, fish, insects, breakable containers, skateboards, weapons or any object that could be hazardous will not be transported.
8. Students shall remain seated from the time they board the bus until they arrive at their destination and the bus door is opened. Seats may be assigned at any time.
9. All parts of the body must be kept inside the bus at all times.
10. Avoid touching the emergency exit and driver operated mechanisms.
11. Talk quietly; make no unnecessary noise. Be absolutely quiet when approaching and crossing railroad tracks.
12. Profanity, vulgarity and obscene gestures are not permitted.
13. Students must be fully attired, including shoes. Spiked or cleated shoes shall not be worn.
14. Students onboard buses may be under video surveillance at any time.
