SUPPORTS DISTRICT'S GOAL #II.A

Topic:

Consideration of Proposal for Helix Charter High School to Sublease a Portion of the School Site for a Community Garden

Issue:

Helix and the City of La Mesa are interested in developing an agreement for use of approximately 6,000 square feet of the school site for a community garden.

The MOU between the District and Helix states that the District agrees to allow Helix exclusive use of the site for the sole purpose of operating the Charter School and its related educational programs. Under the MOU the District must grant approval prior to Helix entering into any sublease.

Plan:

Helix is hereby requesting permission to sublease a portion of the school site for a community garden. Since the existing MOU between Helix and the District covers issues of insurance and indemnification that have been Board approved, this proposed agreement between Helix and the City of La Mesa would result in minimal risk to the District.


